

### PRIOR TO INSTALLATION


**IMPORTANT:** Please inspect your new shower before installation to ensure no damage has occurred during transit. If damage has occurred, or visible defects exist, do not proceed with installation and advise retailer immediately. No claims will be accepted after installation has commenced. Product must be installed by a licensed plumber.



### INSTALLATION STEPS


1

- Fix expansion bolt into the wall in desired position.
- Remove chrome caps from top pillar. Mount the top pillar with the screw, then replace the cap.





- Connect hose to outlet elbow & handset.
- Ensure the conical nut is connected to the handset.

- Remove chrome cap from bottom pillar & insert rail, fix bottom pillar with the screw & replace the cap.
- To adjust slider position, push button to unlock and release button to lock the slider.




### ELBOW INSTALLATION

**IMPORTANT:** Before you begin, turn off the water supply.



- Apply the thread seal tape to the nipple.
- Screw the elbow onto the nipple. Ensure that the elbow is oriented vertically with outlet oriented downwards.

- Connect hose to outlet elbow & handset.
- Ensure the conical nut is connected to the handset.
